

Getting to the venue

IMPORTANT 2009 CHANGES TO VENUE PARKING

The event is conducted in and around ExCeL Exhibition Centre, Royal Victoria Dock, London E16 1XL. www.excel-london.co.uk The recommended method of transport is by car or train as the DLR will not allow bikes.

BY CAR

ExCeL is accessed from the A13, which is not affected by the event route. This can be reached from central London, Blackwall and Rotherhithe Tunnels, the A406 North Circular, M25 and M11. Please check for any weekend road works that may affect these routes. ExCeL Parking is signed from both Gallions Reach roundabout and Canning Town.

There will be road closures in operation for the duration of the event in particular Sunday. Please see our website for full details.

VENUE PARKING

PLEASE NOTE DUE TO PHASE 2 CONSTRUCTION AT THE EXCEL CENTRE THERE IS NO PARKING IN THE EAST CAR PARK WHATSOEVER.

All competitors and visitors are urged to park in the Peruvian Car Park which can be located from the map.

Key Changes for 2009

- No East Entrance into ExCeL (due to phase 2 construction).
- No East Car Park (due to phase 2 construction).
- There is a new car park called the Peruvian Car Park, please see on map below.
- Please allow 15 – 20 minutes to walk from the Peruvian Car Park.
- There will be a shuttle bus from there provided for spectators (you cannot take bikes on this).
- The daily rate for parking is £10.
- For all Sunday competitors racking on Saturday there is free parking for 2 hours in the Peruvian Car Park only.
- The Jubilee Line is closed between Stanmore and Waterloo.

COSTS: All parking (spectator and competitor) is available at a daily rate of £10. For competitors racking on the Saturday for Sunday PM racing you will be able to park free at the Peruvian Car Park only for up to 2 hours. Please mention this to the car parking attendant on entry.

The west multi-storey and the Undercroft (accessed from the West entrance) have a height restriction of 2m – please use the Peruvian Car Park if you transport your bike on a roof rack or if you have a high or wide vehicle.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT - IMPORTANT TRAVEL INFORMATION

BICYCLES ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE DOCKLANDS LIGHT RAILWAY

ExCeL London is connected to the Jubilee line at Canning Town via a 3 minute DLR journey. DLR has advised us that they will NOT accept any bicycles at any point over the weekend.

The JUBILEE LINE will be closed between Stanmore and Waterloo (1st / 2nd August) due to essential engineering works but there are no problems reported from Waterloo to Stratford. The DLR is set to run a normal service.

Nearest Train Stations are:

Stratford 3.5 miles from ExCeL. West Ham 1.8 miles from ExCeL. We strongly advise competitors to arrive at the venue using private transport although the DLR remains open for spectator use.

NB: Plan your journey carefully, because roads will be closed for racing.
